



NEW GILLIBRAND REPORT: OVER 14,000 NY WOMEN DIAGNOSED WITH BREAST CANCER EACH YEAR, 3,000 LOSE THEIR LIVES

More than a quarter of a million women in America were diagnosed with cancer last year, according to the American Cancer Society. In New York alone, an average of over 14,000 women are diagnosed with breast cancer each year, and an average of nearly 3,000 lose their battle with the disease each year, according to the New York State Department of Health.
