



**NEW GILLIBRAND REPORT: Approximately 1.1 Million New York Homeowners Do Not Itemize Federal Tax Returns, Need Property Tax Relief**

**Making Property Taxes Fully Deductable For All Would Save New York Homeowners Approximately \$1 Billion**

According to data from the U.S. Census and the Tax Foundation, approximately 1.1 million New Yorkers who currently do not itemize their federal tax returns and cannot deduct their property taxes could benefit from legislation U.S. Senator Kirsten Gillibrand has introduced to make property taxes fully deductible for all homeowners. The measure would provide additional tax relief for up to 30 million Americans, and help save New York homeowners approximately \$1 billion.
