A BILL

To nullify the applicability of the Act of July 2, 1948, with respect to the territory of the Seneca Nation of Indians in New York, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Seneca Nation Law
5 Enforcement Efficiency Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. NULLIFICATION OF EFFECT OF LAW.**

7 (a) DEFINITION OF TERRITORY.—In this section, the
8 term “territory” means any land of the Seneca Nation of

1 Indians that is Indian country (as defined in section 1151
2 of title 18, United States Code).

3 (b) NULLIFICATION.—Subject to written concurrence
4 of the Attorney General and the Seneca Nation of Indians,
5 the jurisdiction granted to the State of New York by the
6 Act of July 2, 1948 (62 Stat. 1224, chapter 809; 25
7 U.S.C. 232), shall not apply with respect to the territory
8 of the Seneca Nation of Indians, subject to the condition
9 that the Attorney General shall consult in advance with
10 the Seneca Nation of Indians and the State of New York
11 prior to making such concurrence.
