

GILLIBRAND: 3-POINT PLAN TO ADDRESS AUTISM

NEW COUNTY-BY-COUNTY REPORT Estimates More Than 29,000 New York Children Struggling with

Autism

Study Shows Autism Affects More New York Children than Pediatric Cancer, Diabetes, AIDS Combined, But Insurance Companies Not Covering Necessary Treatments

With reports showing Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD) affect 1 in 150 New York children – more than pediatric cancer, diabetes and AIDS combined – and with insurance companies denying coverage for effective treatments, U.S. Senator Kirsten Gillibrand developed a three-point plan to help families with children suffering from ASD. Senator Gillibrand is joining Senator Dick Durbin to mandate insurance companies cover ASD, authoring new legislation, called the *Uniformed Services with Autism (USA) Heroes Act*, requiring TRICARE, the military health insurance program to cover autism treatment. Additionally, Senator Gillibrand is urging greater federal investments for autism research to help improve treatment for children and families living with ASD. Nearly 30,000 children across New York suffer from autism and could benefit from Senator Gillibrand's plan.
