

NEW YORK'S SHRINKING MANUFACTURING SECTOR:

Nearly One-Quarter of New York Manufacturing Base Lost

Nearly 10,000 Manufacturers Have Received Assistance from MEP Program

Amidst the greatest economic crisis since the Great Depression, America's manufacturing sector is reeling, with 30 percent of job loss has been from the manufacturing sector since December of 2007. New York alone lost over 160,000 manufacturing jobs between 2001 and 2008 – nearly one-quarter of our manufacturing base. Fifty-two out of sixty-two of New York's counties have sustained substantial manufacturing job loss.

The Federal Manufacturing Extension Partnership (MEP) Program helps many manufacturers to improve their companies. The MEP Program has helped 9,881 manufacturing companies in New York over the last ten years — and this program is needed now more than ever.

County Statistics for New York City:

New York City lost 58,507 manufacturing jobs from 2001 to 2008. However, in the past ten years, **2,385 companies** have benefited as a result of the MEP program, including retaining and creating new jobs.
