



NEW GILLIBRAND REPORT: NEARLY 3 MILLION NEW YORK SCHOOL CHILDREN ENROLLED IN NATIONAL SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAM

Program Provided Over Half a Billion Dollars for New York Schools Last Year

According to a new report from the office of U.S. Senator Kirsten Gillibrand, nearly 3 million schoolchildren across New York State are enrolled in the National School Lunch program, which provided more than \$510 million to local school districts last school year. A small portion of this funding, approximately 5 percent, comes from New York State.

In New York City, nearly 1.2 million school children are enrolled in the National School Lunch program, which provided nearly \$300 million for school lunches last year.
